'UNLIKELIEST HERO' DESM

Desmond T. Doss, Sr., the only conscientious objector awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor during World War II, died March 23 at 87 at his home in Piedmont, Alabama.

More than 1,600 attended his funeral at Collegedale, Tennessee on April 1, and 500 were present two days later for the burial service with full military honors at the Chattanooga National Cemetery.

Doss did not believe in using a gun or killing because of the sixth commandment, "Thou shalt not kill," but he never liked being called a conscientious objector. He preferred the term conscientious cooperator.

Following the bombing of Pearl Harbor, he was offered a deferment from military service if he would continue working at the Newport News shipyard, but he preferred to wear the army uniform and salute the flag, going on the battlefield as a medic to save others.

Assigned to the 307th Infantry Regiment of the 77th Division, he was harassed and ridiculed for his beliefs. Two officers did their best to have him expelled from the army as refusing a direct order and as a mental case. After one of them later had his life saved by Doss, he declared that Desmond was one of the bravest men on earth.

UNAFRAID FOR HIMSELF

When the 77th Division came under fire at Guam, Leyte, and Okinawa, Doss was always on hand if an infantry man was wounded. His fellow soldiers began to respect him when they saw how totally unafraid he was for his own safety and how he was always willing to go after the wounded, no matter how great the danger. On one occasion in Okinawa, Doss refused to take cover from enemy fire as he rescued approximately 75 wounded

soldiers, carrying them one-by-one and lowering them over the edge of the 400-foot Maeda Escarpment (Hacksaw Ridge). He did not stop until he had brought everyone to safety nearly 12 hours later.

Doss was seriously wounded in his legs by a grenade during a night attack on high ground near Shuri. Rather

than call another aid man from cover, he cared for his own injuries and waited five hours before litter-bearers reached him. When the trio was caught in an enemy tank attack, Doss saw a more critically wounded man nearby and crawled off the litter so the bearers could give their first attention to that soldier. He was again struck, suffering a compound fracture of one arm, but he bound a rifle stock to his shattered arm as a splint and crawled 300 yards over rough terrain to the aid station.

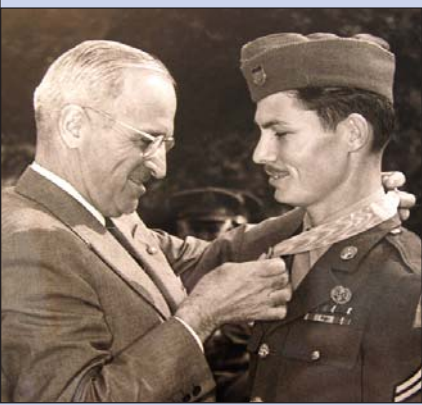
Though Doss

recovered from most of his injuries, tests showed he had tuberculosis, which resulted in the loss of one lung. An overdose of antibiotics destroyed his hearing. He was given 100 percent disability.

STATUE AND FILMS

Two years ago, on July 4, 2004, a statue of Doss was placed in the National Museum of Patriotism in Atlanta, along with statues of Dr. Martin Luther King and President Jimmy Carter. The same year, a feature-length documentary, "The Conscientious Objector," told Doss' story of faith, heroism, and bravery. A feature movie portraying Doss' story is planned.

Pastor Lonnie Melashenko notes, "Desmond Doss was a paragon of virtue. It is difficult to adequately describe someone who exemplified integrity, faith, courage, God-likeness, purity, strength, perspicuity, and pristine Christianity like he did."



When Desmond Doss was awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor in 1945, President Harry Truman told him, "I'm proud of you, you really deserve this. I consider this a greater honor than being president."
